Interpreting the grades in the mid year reports

Your child will be given an overall progression point which demonstrates your child's achievement in each of the curriculum areas assessed this semester:

Highly Accomplished - your child is well above the standard at this time of year.

Extending - your child is above the standard at this time of year.

Achieved - your child is at the standard at this time of year.

Working Towards - your child is below the standard at this time of year.

Not Evident - your child has not engaged in this learning.

Each curriculum area reported on has been broken down into a number of specific learning outcomes that have been taught throughout the semester. Each skill has been assessed using the same five point scale as above.

School gates

The school gates open at 8.30am every day. Three members of the leadership team supervise the student entry and play in the mornings. **The school gates are closed at 8.55am in the mornings and 3.45pm in the afternoon.** Families entering or exiting outside these times need to do so via the office. Please make sure students arriving late are signed in by the adult dropping them at school.

On Friday the middle school students participated in an incursion from **Mad about Science.** The incursion was all about Sustainability and how humans are impacting our Earth. The grade 3/4 were scientists for the day and completed experiments on greenhouse gases, climate change, 5 r's of saving the planet!







During this term a group of the year 4's went to **Parade College Bundoora for a soccer clinic**. It all started with our very hard working year 3/4 teacher Mrs Davies, thank you Miss Davies for this amazing experience! At the first session some of us were confident because some of us already play soccer and some of us were not playing soccer so they were nervous but we were relieved that it wasn't scary at all and most of us had lots of fun!

There were 4 rotations, the first activity was about dribbling the ball and kicking it. The second activity was mini soccer games, even if the other team lost or won we were all supportive. The third activity was Octopus but with the ball and the defenders had to try and kick the balls away. The last activity was like Piggy in the Middle but with the ball and you would try to kick the ball out and score. It was great to see everyone progress every week!

News from the Maths Hub






This year, we have 4 Senior School students who have been appointed as Numeracy Leaders. As part of their role, they are supporting the mathematics learning in other year levels and informing the community about the learning at St Peter's. REcently, they visited the Year 2 classrooms and composed the following reflection...

Dear parent / guardians

We hope you are all doing great. A few weeks ago, we went to the grade two classrooms. In 2DD, they started with a

maths game. In that game, they had to pick five random cards and add the total amount. They were excellent in the game. They then learnt different numbers that made the same total. They did some examples on the floor. Then they went off and used a balance scale to make equivalent sums. For example, Melanie's number was 6. The sum she came up with was three plus three and two plus four.





In 2ED the students were learning about patterns and were trying to use them to add numbers together.

In 2BM the Year 2's were very productive. They were playing a maths game in which they rolled dice and made an equation. They had to see who could solve it first.

We had a great time working with the Year 2's and hearing them share their thinking and ideas! They really like playing maths games in Year 2!
